Residential Well Testing


An update on the Residential Well Testing Program was given. The committee has received residential water well testing permission slips for 47 applicants in Accomack County and 43 applicants in Northampton County.

The timeframe for collecting the samples will be the last week in October. There will be a minimum of three teams, (2 to a team), going out in the field to collect the samples. Britt McMillan is sending one staff member to assist us. This person is experienced in collecting samples and also from the well heads. If anyone is interested in volunteering with this project, it would be greatly appreciated.

There was discussion about calling the applicants prior to the collect time to obtain additional information which would be useful. Britt McMillan will coordinate a questionnaire,

Technical Evaluation for Proposed Groundwater Withdrawal Presentation

New Business:

Remote Policy

The remote policy options were explained to the Committee. The Committee will have to choose which policy option they want to adopt. The Code of Virginia has increased the number of potential virtual meetings to 50% which is five for our Committee meetings. The policy they choose would have to be readopted yearly. This could take place in June when the Committee had elections. Additional rules would prohibit the policy from stopping members from voting during a virtual meeting and restrictions on not holding them with another meeting. There was also a caregiver option which has been expanded. If the Committee would want a remote policy, Staff Meil will draft a policy with their guidance. There will be further discussion at the next meeting.

Water Supply Planning

The state has required The Virginia Register of Regulations to publish a Local & Regional Water Supply Plan. The final regulations for Local & Regional Water Supply Planning were published in the Virginia Register of Regulations. The link is listed below.

Accomack County has designated Jeremy W. Shifflett as the county representative with Stewart Hall the alternate. There has not been one designated presently for Northampton County. More information to come in the future.

6. Eastern Shore of VA Ground Water Resource Protection & Preservation Plan

The plan was shared with the Committee in July. They were requested to review the plan. Staff has begun a tentative prioritized Scope of Work for discussion purposes. Guidance from the Committee was requested. Residential Well Testing was mentioned to be included in the Scope of Work. Further discussion will be continued at the next meeting.



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7. September 17, 2024 Groundwater Consultant Report

GWC Advisor McMillan referred to the draft permit for Tankard Farm, (GWI000358). DEQ is accepting public comment through September 30, 2024. It is a renewal of a current valid permit. The groundwater is used for agricultural use. An on-site pond provides irrigation water with groundwater from two production wells supplementing the pond supply. The wells which supply the water are screened in the Upper Yorktown-Bastover aquifer. The draft permit is requesting a lower amount which represents a 57% reduction than what is in the current permit.

Regarding the potential for saltwater intrusion, Tankard Farm is located south of the Town of Cape Charles in an area where the freshwater lens naturally thins as it approaches the southern tip of the Eastern Shore, Fresh groundwater is expected to be naturally limited in this area. Somewhat mitigating this, the location of the wells is close to the center of the "spine" near Route 13, where the freshwater lens is thickest.

Groundwater has been used from these irrigation wells for greater than 10 years and the amount that will be used will not increase over historical use. Any change in chloride levels would likely have already occurred.

Member Hershey and Member Grossman commended this was a positive change. The permit request showed a more realistic number.
